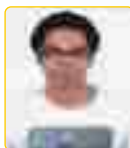

With correct responses, the level of difficulty increases, and conversely - with incorrect responses, the level of difficulty decreases. The score does not depend only on the number of correct and incorrect answers. It also depends on the difficulty level of the questions encountered. The weightage for tougher questions is more than that for the easier questions. The test is administered on the computer, one can review any number of questions and make upto 3 revisions within each section. Data Insights is computer adaptive.
