Analytical Writing:

- Test taker will give 30 minutes of time for each task
- The writing section is granted on a scoring scale of 0-6 with half point increment

Verbal Reasoning:

- Each section consists of 20 questions to be completed in 30 minutes

- Scoring scale will be 130-170, with 1 point increment

Quantitative Reasoning:

What is the admission process?

For most people who wish to study abroad, the admission process can be one of the most challenging procedure that they face. It normally involves filling out basic information along with your academic transcripts, writing a statement of purpose (SOP) and reporting your GRE® Test and/or TOEFL® iBT/IELTS/PTE scores. Applicant also needs to submit couple of LOR (Letter of Recommendation). The admission committee mainly bases its decision on your GRE® Test score, English language test score and academic performance with the other paraphernalia carrying some significance.
